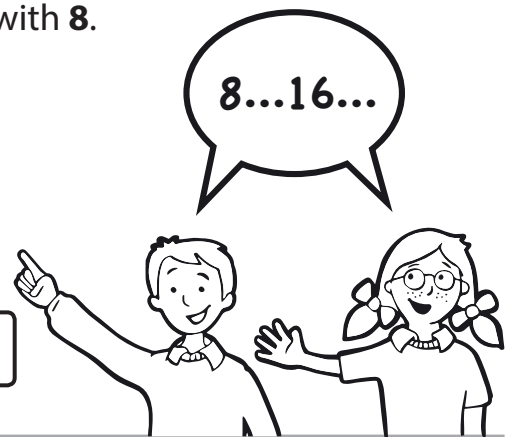


2 Year 3 were counting forwards in **eights**, starting with **8**.
